2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4722-A, as amended by PL 2017, c. 466, §10, is repealed.
3	SUMMARY
4 5	This bill repeals the provisions of law that allow diplomas indicating graduation from a secondary school to be based on a student's demonstration of proficiency.
