Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the 3 Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry shall develop a fully off-road trail 4 corridor linking the East Coast Greenway's northern terminus at the Ferry Point 5 International Bridge in Calais with the Down East Sunrise Trail's eastern terminus at 6 Ayers Junction.

8 This resolve directs the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the 9 Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to develop a fully off-road trail 10 corridor linking the East Coast Greenway's northern terminus at the Ferry Point 11 International Bridge in Calais with the Down East Sunrise Trail's eastern terminus at 12 Ayers Junction.
