1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 34-B MRSA §3611, sub-§7, ¶C is enacted to read:
3	C. At least 33% of the membership of a local council that consists of 6 or fewer
4	members and at least 40% of the membership of a local council that consists of 7 or
5	more members must consist of adults receiving mental health services.
6	SUMMARY
7	This bill amends the laws governing the membership of local councils within the
8	Consumer Council System of Maine. It requires that at least 33% of the membership of a
9	local council that consists of 6 or fewer members and at least 40% of the membership of a
10	local council that consists of 7 or more members must consist of adults receiving mental
11	health services.
