1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §1221, sub-§10, ¶H is enacted to read:
3	H. A governmental entity who elects to make payments in lieu of contributions into
4	the unemployment compensation fund as provided in this section is not liable to make
5	such payments with respect to benefits paid to any individual who voluntarily
6	separates from employment.
7	SUMMARY
8	This bill specifies that a governmental entity that elects to make payments in lieu of
9	contributions into the unemployment compensation fund is not liable to make payments
10	with respect to an individual who voluntarily separates from employment.
