1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §104, as amended by PL 2017, c. 332, §3, is further amended to read:
4	§104. Execution of process
5 6 7	Sheriffs and their deputies and constables shall execute all legal processes directed to them by the commissioners. A civil deputy, as defined in section 351, subsection 5, shall serve civil process as directed by the sheriff.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill amends the law governing execution of process to remove a reference to constables.
