1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Immigrant workforce development council.** The Department of  
3 Labor shall establish an immigrant workforce development council composed of relevant  
4 stakeholders. The department, after consultation with the council, shall provide funds to  
5 entities that promote integration of immigrants into the workforce and community  
6 through English language acquisition programs, job training and educational programs,  
7 housing and transportation assistance and assistance in acquiring appropriate credentials.  
8 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Department of Labor in  
9 consultation with the council shall develop a competitive process in which funds provided  
10 to the Department of Labor in section 2 are to be distributed to qualified entities.

11 **Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and  
12 allocations are made.

13 **LABOR, DEPARTMENT OF**

14 **Immigrant Workforce Integration Program N297**

15 Initiative: Provides funds to support integration of immigrants into the workforce and  
16 community through English language acquisition programs, job training and educational  
17 programs, housing and transportation assistance and assistance in acquiring appropriate  
18 credentials.

25 This bill directs the Department of Labor to establish an immigrant workforce  
26 development council and, after consultation with the council, to distribute funds through a  
27 competitive process to entities that promote integration of immigrants into the workforce

29 the workforce and community.
