'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §51 is enacted to read:
<u>§51. Block grant set aside; federally recognized Indian nations, tribes and bands in</u> <u>the State</u>
Notwithstanding section 5327 or any other provision of law to the contrary, for each block grant received by the department from the Federal Government, the department shall annually set aside an amount equal to at least 12% of the total amount of the block grant to be awarded to federally recognized Indian nations, tribes and bands in the State. The administration of such grants is by the tribal district. The department shall adopt rules to implement this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A. For purposes of this section, "tribal district" has the same meaning as in section 411, subsection 12.'

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, removes the set-aside amount to vulnerable communities and changes the required set aside from 10%

#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

Requiring 12% of Federal Block Grant funds be set aside for Indian nations, tribes and bands limits the amount of funding available for the purposes for which they are currently being used. If the remaining 88% of Federal Block Grant funds are not sufficient to accomplish those purposes, or the purposes and programs are not modified to account for a reduction in expenditures, General Fund appropriations may be needed to supplement the federal resources.
