COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 856, L.D. 1182, Bill, "An Act To Improve School Safety by Requiring Law Enforcement Visits"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Improve School Safety by Allowing Law Enforcement Visits'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §6555 in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "must be visited at least 2 times" and inserting the following: 'may be visited at least one time'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, removes the requirement that a public school must be visited at least twice a week by a law enforcement officer and instead provides that a public school may be visited at least one time per week by a law enforcement officer.
