COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 397, L.D. 1277, Bill, "An Act To Require the Director of the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention To Be Credentialed"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §20 by striking out all of subsection 1 (page 1, lines 4 to 11 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

1. Qualifications. The Director of the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention, referred to in this section as "the director," must have demonstrated experience in administration of public health or clinical medicine and:

A. Be licensed, or eligible for licensure, as a physician under Title 32, chapter 36 or 48 or as an advanced practice registered nurse under Title 32, chapter 31; or

B. Have a degree in public health from an accredited school of public health or any equivalent combination of education and experience in public health.'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF

Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention 0143

Initiative: Provides funding for the reorganization of one State Health Officer and Director of the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention position from range 61 to range 70 to align the compensation with the assigned duties and qualifications. Also provides allocation for related All Other costs.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$25,569 in fiscal year 2019-20 and \$27,292 in fiscal year 2020-21 for the reorganization of one State Health Officer and Director Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention position from range 61 to range 70 to align the compensation with the assigned duties and qualifications. Other Special Revenue Funds allocations will also be required for the federal match.

The proposed 2020-21 biennial budget includes an initiative to increase the funding of this position. If that budget initiative is approved, the funding in this bill would no longer be required.
