10 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 933, L.D. 1290, Bill, "An Act To
11 Increase Transparency with Regard to Pawnshops"

12 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the
13 following:

14 'Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3962, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1993, c. 59, §2, is further
15 amended to read:

16 3. List filed with law enforcement agency and regional tracking system. Before
17 the 15th day of every month, the Within 10 days of a transaction, a pawnbroker shall file
18 with the law enforcement agency of jurisdiction submit to a regional property and
19 recovery tracking system administered by a regional law enforcement support
20 organization designated by the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of State Police, in a
21 form acceptable to that agency the recipient, a summary report of the pawn transactions
22 entered into during the preceding calendar month. transaction, including:

23 A. The name and address of the pawnbroker;

24 B. The date and time of the transaction;

25 C. The name, address, date of birth, telephone number, if any, and unique identifying
26 number on the written proof of identification required under section 3971 of the
27 consumer or seller; and

28 D. Information on every item involved in the transaction, including a description of
29 the item, manufacturer, if known, serial number, if any, and amount of the loan or
30 purchase price given for the item.

31 Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2020.'

SUMMARY

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This amendment removes the criminal provision included in the bill, removes the requirement for reporting to a law enforcement agency of jurisdiction and provides an effective date of July 1, 2020.
