SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 940, L.D. 1297, Bill, "An Act To Reduce Youth Cancer Risk"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §689-A in subsection 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "tanning device" the following: 'unless that individual has a written prescription from a physician licensed under Title 32, chapter 36 or 47'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §689-A in subsection 3 in paragraph A in the last line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "tanning device" the following: 'unless that individual has a written prescription from a physician licensed under Title 32, chapter 36 or 47'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §689-A in subsection 5 in paragraph A in the last line (page 2, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "tanning facility" the following: 'unless that individual has a written prescription from a physician licensed under Title 32, chapter 36 or 47'

SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits a tanning facility from allowing an individual under 18 years of age to use a tanning device unless the individual has a written prescription from a physician.
