The Maine Workforce, Research, Development and Student Achievement Institute Steering Committee, referred to in this section as "the steering committee," is established to advise the Legislature and the University of Maine System on all matters related to the institute. With the exception of ex officio members, steering committee members must be appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House for a term of 2 years as follows. The steering committee shall meet at least 4 times each year and must include the following:

22	(1) One member from an independent college in the State;
23	(2) One member from the Maine Community College System;

The amendment eliminates the requirement for the Legislature to contract with the University of Maine System to establish and maintain the Maine Workforce, Research, Development and Student Achievement Institute and eliminates the \$250,390 ongoing appropriation for this contract and for other costs to the Legislature. The additional costs to the Legislature for a legislator to serve on the Maine Workforce, Research, Development and Student Achievement Institute Steering Committee are assumed to be minor and can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
