1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	CONCEPT DRAFT
3	SUMMARY
4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to amend the provisions in law regarding high-quality after-school
6	programs under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 318. Currently, funds to
7	provide high-quality after-school programs are provided by the After-school Program
8	Fund, which receives a substantial amount of funding from the Federal Government that
9	may be terminated or no longer available in the coming years. This bill proposes to seek
10	new funding for the After-school Program Fund and to increase the quality of the after-
11	school programs, including requiring matching funds from the schools that receive the
12	funds and to make grants from the fund competitive. An after-school program that is a
13	recipient of funding from the fund must have as measurable outcomes for the students
14	academic improvement, social emotional learning and family engagement. Criteria for
15	competitive grants would seek to improve or raise the quality of after-school programs by
16	giving preference to schools that would collaborate with and leverage existing
17	community resources that have demonstrated effectiveness, engage in outreach to
18	children and youth and involve local governments, including parks and recreation
19	departments and other schools.
