By January 10, 2020, the commissioner shall report the 20 21 findings of the study group, including any recommendations for legislation, to the Joint 22 Standing Committee on Taxation and the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. Each committee may submit legislation to the Second Regular 23 Session of the 129th Legislature regarding the results of the report.' 24 25 SUMMARY This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, changes the bill to a 26 resolve and directs the Commissioner of Health and Human Services, in consultation with 27 the director of opioid response in the Executive Department and the Department of 28
