1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10853, sub-§18 is enacted to read:
3	18. Gold star family registration plate holder. A complimentary license to hunt,
4	trap and fish, including permits, stamps and other permissions needed to hunt, may be
5	issued, upon application, to the holder of a registration certificate and a set of gold star
6	family registration plates pursuant to Title 29-A, section 524-B.
7	SUMMARY
8	This bill allows the holder of a registration certificate and a set of gold star family
9	registration plates pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29-A, section 524-B to be
10	issued a complimentary license to hunt, trap and fish, including permits, stamps and other
11	permissions needed to hunt.
