15	Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

17	Maine Charter School Commission serving on the effective date of this Act may continue
18	to serve until that member's term has expired.'
19	SUMMARY
20	This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, clarifies that the
21	Governor's appointments to the Maine Charter School Commission are subject to review
22	by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education
23	matters and to confirmation by the Senate. This amendment also removes the provision
24	of the bill that ends the terms on the effective date of this legislation of members of the
25	commission who are not members of the State Board of Education and instead provides
