1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3971, sub-§5 is enacted to read:
3 4	5. Exemption. An auctioneer licensed under Title 32, chapter 5-B is exempt from the requirements of this section.
5 6	Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §291-A, sub-§2, as amended by PL 2011, c. 286, Pt. C, §2, is repealed.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill exempts auctioneers from the requirement to record the date of purchase, the seller's name and address and a brief description of the property, including any identification numbers, before completing the purchase of any used personal property.
