COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1201, L.D. 1677, Bill, "An Act To Allow Reentry Houses as Part of Supervised Community Confinement"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §3036-B in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "defined" the following: '; requirement'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §3036-B in subsection 1 in the last line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "facility." the following: 'A reentry house must meet all state and local building and life safety codes for the type of building in which the reentry house is located.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires a reentry house to meet all state and local building and life safety codes for the type of building in which the reentry house is located.
