be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §589-A is enacted to read:
§589-A. Notification of violation to affected municipality
When the department issues a notice of violation or initiates an enforcement action for a violation of this chapter pursuant to section 347-A, the department shall provide notice of that violation to each municipality in which the violation occurred.
SUMMARY
This bill requires the Department of Environmental Protection to notify an affected municipality when the department issues a notice of violation or initiates an enforcement action relating to an air quality violation.
