4 5 6	The department shall include in each license issued by the department under this Title a requirement that a person who is independent from the licensee perform testing to determine compliance with the license and this Title.

8	This bill requires the Department of Environmental Protection to include in each
9	license issued by the department a requirement that an independent entity perform testing
10	to determine compliance with the license.
