HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1232,
L.D. 1730, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Governing Elections"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph (page 2, line 6 in amendment).

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 46 (page 2, lines 7 to 29 in amendment).

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

This amendment strikes a provision amending the procedures used to collect signatures on petitions for local initiatives.
