Soliciting prohibited. A person may not solicit or accept contributions for a campaign as defined in section 1052, subsection 1 or for the purpose of qualifying a 15 Maine Clean Election Act candidate pursuant to section 1125 within the voting place.' 16 17 Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively. 18 19 SUMMARY 20 This amendment prohibits within the voting place the solicitation or acceptance of 21 campaign contributions of Maine Clean Election Act candidate qualifying contributions. 22
