14 15 16 17 18 19 20	'5. Operation and maintenance and asset management; rules. The department may adopt rules establishing standards for operation and maintenance and asset management for publicly owned treatment works and municipal satellite collection systems. For the purposes of this subsection, "municipal satellite collection system" has the same meaning as in section 414-D, subsection 1, paragraph A. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are major substantive rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'
21 22	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
23	SUMMARY
24 25 26 27	This amendment designates as major substantive rules the rules the Department of Environmental Protection may adopt establishing standards for operation and maintenance and asset management for publicly owned treatment works and municipal satellite collection systems.
