Initiative: Provides an ongoing allocation to allow funds in the Maine Ground and Surface Waters Clean-up and Response Fund to be disbursed for loans and grants for department-approved rebate programs to retrofit, repair, replace or remove aboveground and underground oil storage tanks and associated piping at residential dwellings.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes an ongoing allocation of \$500,000 starting in fiscal year 2020-21 from the Maine Ground and Surface Waters Clean-up and Response Fund (MGSWCR) within the Department of Environmental Protection for loans and grants for rebate programs to retrofit, repair, replace or remove aboveground and underground oil storage tanks and associated piping at residential dwellings. The MGSWCR has sufficient resources to fund additional expenditures.
