Reduction in tuition revenue - Higher educational institutions

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Expanding the tuition waiver for the child of a veteran who is attending state-supported postsecondary institutions to include a certificate program and master's degree programs will result in a reduction in tuition revenue to the state supported higher educational institutions. The amount of tuition loss can not be determined at this time. However, a estimate provided by the University of Maine System anticipates revenue loss of approximately \$350,000 per year. The system has indicated that unless General Fund appropriations are provided to offset the revenue loss, programs and services offered by the university may be impacted.
