COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1327, L.D. 1856, “Resolve, To Support Individuals with Acute Mental Health Needs”

Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and inserting the following:

**Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services to increase MaineCare rates. Resolved:** That the Department of Health and Human Services shall amend its rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 45.03 to provide reimbursement for patients discharged from Southern Maine Health Care's psychiatric inpatient unit in the amount of \$10,166 per distinct discharge for the period beginning with the effective date of this section and ending January 15, 2023. No later than 30 days following the effective date of this section, the department shall amend its rule pursuant to this section and submit the amended rule to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

**Sec. 2. Department of Health and Human Services to seek available funds for uninsured patients. Resolved:** That the Department of Health and Human Services shall seek and apply for available federal funds or funds from any other sources to pay the costs of providing inpatient psychiatric care to uninsured patients who are discharged from acute care hospitals.

**Sec. 3. Report. Resolved:** That, no later than January 15, 2022, the Department of Health and Human Services shall submit a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters regarding the progress the department has made in developing a reimbursement rate to provide inpatient psychiatric care under its rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 45.03. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters is authorized to report out legislation related to the report to the Second Regular Session of the 130th Legislature.

**Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved:** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

19 **SUMMARY**

20 This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, reduces the  
 21 reimbursement rate per discharge to cover the cost of providing care to MaineCare  
 22 members in Southern Maine Health Care's psychiatric inpatient unit and limits the new  
 23 reimbursement rate to the period beginning on the effective date of this legislation and  
 24 ending January 15, 2022. The amendment directs the Department of Health and Human  
 25 Services to seek and apply for federal funds and funds from any other sources to pay the  
 26 costs of providing psychiatric services to uninsured patients. The amendment also directs  
 27 the Department of Health and Human Services to submit a report to the joint standing  
 28 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters  
 29 regarding the progress the department has made in developing a reimbursement rate to  
 30 provide inpatient psychiatric care under its rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual,  
 31 Chapter III, Section 45.03. The committee is authorized to report out legislation related to  
 32 the report to the Second Regular Session of the 130th Legislature. This amendment  
 33 includes a provision to repeal the resolve January 15, 2022.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes a one-time General Fund appropriation to Department of Health and Human Services of \$74,714 in fiscal year 2020-21 to amend its rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 45.03 to provide reimbursement for patients discharged from Southern Maine Health Care's psychiatric inpatient unit in the amount of \$10,166 per distinct discharge. The increased rate is repealed on January 15, 2022. Federal Expenditures Fund allocation is also included for the FMAP match.
