The commissioner shall make a reasonable effort to 18 19 appoint a member who has at least 5 years of relevant experience. Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or 20 21 section number to read consecutively. **SUMMARY** 22

This amendment changes the member of the Shellfish Advisory Council with a demonstrated knowledge of biological science from a nonvoting member, as proposed in the bill, to a voting member. It also requires the Commissioner of Marine Resources to make a reasonable effort to appoint as this member a person who has a minimum of 5 years of relevant experience.
