#### An Act Regarding Prior Authorization for Medication-assisted Treatment for Opioid Use Disorder under the MaineCare Program

#### 2 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-EEE is enacted to read:

## <u>§3174-EEE. Prior authorization of medication-assisted treatment for opioid use</u> <u>disorder</u>

5 The department may not require under the MaineCare program prior authorization for medication-assisted treatment for opioid use disorder for the prescription of at least one 6 drug for each therapeutic class of medication used in medication-assisted treatment, 7 except that the department may not impose any prior authorization requirements on a 8 pregnant woman for medication-assisted treatment for opioid use disorder. For the 9 purposes of this section, "medication-assisted treatment" means an evidence-based 10 practice that combines pharmacological interventions with substance use disorder 11 counseling. 12

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#### SUMMARY

This bill prohibits the Department of Health and Human Services from requiring under the MaineCare program prior authorization for medication-assisted treatment for opioid use disorder for the prescription of at least one drug for each type of medication used in medication-assisted treatment, except that the department may not require prior authorization for medication-assisted treatment for opioid use disorder for a pregnant woman.
