Child care facilities. "Child care facilities" means facilities that are licensed 19 by the Department of Health and Human Services that provide care for at least 6 children who are less than 18 years of age by persons who are not family members, legal 20 21 guardians or other custodians of the children and that are operated out of nonresidential 22 commercial buildings. To meet this definition, a child care facility must have a director 23 and a sufficient number of staff members whose sole function is to provide necessary 24 child care services.
