1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1111-A, sub-§1, ¶J,** as amended by PL 1981, c. 531, §2,  
3 is further amended to read:

4 J. Containers and other objects, including but not limited to so-called stash cans,  
5 used or intended for use in storing or concealing scheduled drugs; and

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill amends the laws governing drug paraphernalia to specifically include so-  
8 called stash cans as drug paraphernalia, the sale or advertising of which is prohibited.
