COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 712, L.D. 2022, Bill, "An Act To Provide Funding for Capital Improvements and Equipment for Career and Technical Education Centers and Regions"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Provide Funding for Equipment Upgrades for Career and Technical Education Centers and Regions To Meet National Industry Standards'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF

General Purpose Aid for Local Schools 0308

Initiative: Provides one-time funds for equipment upgrades for career and technical education centers and career and technical education regions to meet national industry standards. These funds do not lapse but must be carried forward into the next fiscal year to be used for the same purpose.
