11 12	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
13 14	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
15	Whereas, Maine has one of the highest rates of childhood cancer in the nation; and
16 17	Whereas, federal funding for childhood cancer research is historically less than 5% of the total amount allocated for cancer research; and
18 19 20 21	Whereas, Public Law 2019, chapter 433, "An Act To Advance Children's Cancer Research in Maine," added an option on Maine's tax return form allowing a Maine taxpayer entitled to a tax refund to designate a portion of that refund to be paid into the Maine Children's Cancer Research Fund; and
22 23	Whereas, many Maine taxpayers will file tax forms before the expiration of the 90-day period; and
24 25 26	Whereas, if this Act becomes effective before March 1st, the Governor will issue a proclamation in March that will increase the public's awareness of childhood cancer and may elicit contributions by taxpayers to the Maine Children's Cancer Research Fund; and
27 28 29 30	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

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'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this

Amend the bill by adding before the summary the following:

legislation takes effect when approved.'

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill.

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
