SUMMARY

8 This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, resolves a conflict in 9 the law by clarifying that, when an individual provides documentation that provides proof 10 of voter eligibility in the course of applying for a driver's license or nondriver 11 identification card from the Department of the Secretary of State, Bureau of Motor 12 Vehicles, the individual must be given the opportunity to opt out of voter registration 13 before the bureau creates an electronic pending voter registration record for the 14 individual.
