10 11	Amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting after the 2nd instructional paragraph the following:
12 13 14	'Amend the bill in section 2 in §1612 in subsection 5 in the first blocked paragraph in the 4th line (page 6, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "related to the" the following: 'revenue-based'
15 16 17	Amend the amendment on page 2 in paragraph L in the first line (page 2, line 14 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "analysis of the" the following: 'revenue-based'
18 19	Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
20	SUMMARY
21 22 23	This amendment requires the costs of a stewardship program operated by 2 or more manufacturers to be split between the participating manufacturers based on revenue-based market share instead of just market share.
24 25 26	This amendment also changes the market analysis an operator of a stewardship program is required to do from an analysis of the market share of covered drugs to a revenue-based market share analysis.
