Amend the bill in section 10 in subsection 27 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 35 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "muscle" the following: 'of livestock, an amenable species or an exotic animal as defined by the federal acts'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

This amendment clarifies the definition of "meat" in the provisions of law relating to preparation of livestock and poultry products for human consumption by providing that meat is the muscle of livestock, an amenable species or an exotic animal.
