SUMMARY 28 29 This amendment adds the requirement for the Director of the Office of Professional and Occupational Regulation to consult with the appropriate licensing board, commission 30 31 or personnel administering a regulatory function of the office before exercising discretionary authority to waive examination fees and license fees for applicants for 32 licensure for credentialed individuals from other jurisdictions and for applicants who 33 34 identify themselves as veterans with military service, experience and training. It also includes a requirement for the Office of Professional and Occupational Regulation, or a 35
