COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 114, L.D. 158, "An Act To Eliminate Inactive Boards and Commissions"

- Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.
- Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 6 and 7.
- Amend the bill by striking out all of section 10.
- Amend the bill by striking out all of section 12.
- Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 18 to 25.
- Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the following boards and commissions from the bill:

1. Advisory committee on truancy, dropouts and alternative education;
2. Advisory committee on Fair Competition with Private Enterprise;
3. State Education and Employment Outcomes Task Force; and
4. Tobacco Prevention and Control Advisory Council.
