Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the State Controller shall transfer \$21,712,948 by June 30, 2021 from the unencumbered balance of the Local Road Assistance Program, Highway Fund account in the Department of Transportation to the unallocated surplus of the Highway Fund.

PART C

Sec. C-1. Transfer of funds; Department of Transportation, Bond Interest-Highway account. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the State Controller shall transfer \$70,109 by June 30, 2021 from the unencumbered balance of the Bond Interest-Highway Highway Fund account in the Department of Transportation to the unallocated surplus of the Highway Fund.

PART D

Transfer of funds; Department of Secretary of State, Sec. D-1. Administration - Motor Vehicles program. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the State Controller shall transfer \$2,904,635 by June 30, 2021 from the unencumbered balance in the Department of Secretary of State, Administration - Motor Vehicles program, Highway Fund account to the Highway Fund unallocated surplus.

Amend the bill by adding before the summary the following:

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

The bill makes adjustment to Highway Fund, Other Special Revenue Funds and Federal Expenditures Fund allocations for fiscal year 2020-21 and transfers unencumbered balances in selected programs to the unallocated surplus of the Highway Fund.
