The amendment changes the frequency, from every 2 years to every 5 years, at which a facility must conduct a complete inspection of the cover and seal associated with the internal, floating roof of any aboveground petroleum storage tank equipped with such a roof. The amendment also removes a requirement that the Department of Environmental Protection submit a report to the Joint Standing Committee on Environment and Natural Resources regarding the regulation of air emissions at petroleum storage facilities and removes the appropriations and allocations section providing funding for that report.
