Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$200,000 in fiscal year 2022-23 by requiring the State Controller to transfer \$200,000 from the Medical Use Marijuana Fund within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund no later than June 30, 2023.

As amended, the bill still includes ongoing General Fund appropriations totaling \$400,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2022-23 to the Employment Services Activity program within the Department of Labor to support apprenticeship programs.
