COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 142, L.D. 207, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Chapter 1: Fee Schedule, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Maine Land Use Planning Commission"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "authorized." the following: 'Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 8072, the Maine Land Use Planning Commission shall finally adopt rules no later than October 1, 2021.'

Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

This amendment provides that the Maine Land Use Planning Commission must finally adopt rules no later than October 1, 2021.
