18	'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2023.'
19 20	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

22 23 24 25 26	This amendment eliminates the requirement that the court provide the names of prospective jurors and the contents of juror qualification forms electronically to the attorneys and their agents and investigators and the pro se parties at their request. Nothing in the amendment prohibits the court from providing access to the information electronically.
