Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act Regarding Consumer-owned Water Utilities'


Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 1, 3 and 4.

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" to change the title of the bill and  
to strike from the legislation all provisions except for the provision allocated to the Maine  
Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 6410-A allowing the Public Utilities Commission to  
appoint a receiver to oversee a consumer-owned water utility lacking a sufficient number  
of duly elected trustees.

This amendment removes the one-time transfer from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$200,000 in fiscal year 2021-22, removes the associated allocation and eliminates provisions regarding the Small Consumer-Owned Water Utility Infrastructure Fund.
