9 This bill includes a Highway Fund allocation of \$599,870 in fiscal year 2021-22 and
10 \$1,235,732 in fiscal year 2022-23 to the Department of Transportation for 5 Driver Trainer
11 positions in fiscal year 2021-22 and 5 additional Driver Trainer positions in fiscal year
12 2022-23.
