Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill would allow motor vehicles with a gold star license plate free entry to all state parks. This is estimated to reduce General Fund revenue by \$10,327 annually using the assumptions listed below:

total active gold star license plates	218 cars
29% already buy annual park passes	63 annual passes
63 passes not sold @ \$105 each \$	6,615 revenue loss from passes not sold
71% do not buy annual passes	155 cars
155 cars make 1.5 park visits each year	232 car visits
4 people in car each visit	928 day trips
Average of \$4 per adult visit \$	3,712 revenue loss from day trips not sold
