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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 145, L.D. 338, "An Act To Amend the Law Governing the Maine Lobster Marketing Collaborative"

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Amend the bill by striking out all of section 5 and inserting the following:

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'Sec. 5. 12 MRSA §6455, sub-§9, as enacted by PL 2017, c. 368, §5, is amended to read:

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**9. Repeal.** This section is repealed October 1, ~~2021~~ 2026.'

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Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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**SUMMARY**

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This amendment extends the provision repealing the laws governing the Maine Lobster Marketing Collaborative to October 1, 2026.
