SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 148,
9 L.D. 341, "An Act To Address the Windfall Elimination Provision"

Amend the amendment by striking out the title and substituting the following:

11

**'Resolve, Directing the Maine Public Employees Retirement System To Study and
12 Report on How Statewide Retirement Systems Affected by the Windfall Elimination
13 Provision and Government Pension Offset Can Cooperate on Solutions'**

14

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

15

**'Sec. 1. Maine Public Employees Retirement System to study cooperation of
16 statewide retirement systems. Resolved:** That the Maine Public Employees Retirement
17 System shall study existing cooperation and any further potential cooperation of statewide
18 retirement systems affected by the windfall elimination provision, pursuant to the federal
19 Social Security Amendments of 1983, Public Law 98-21, and the government pension
20 offset, pursuant to the federal Social Security Amendments of 1977, Public Law 95-216.
21 The Maine Public Employees Retirement System shall consult and collaborate with any
22 applicable retirement associations, such as the National Association of State Retirement
23 Administrators, as necessary. The Maine Public Employees Retirement System shall
24 submit a report with its recommendations, including any suggested legislation, no later than
25 January 1, 2022 to the Joint Standing Committee on Labor and Housing. The committee
26 may report out a bill based on the report and recommendations to the Second Regular
27 Session of the 130th Legislature.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
29 section number to read consecutively.


This amendment replaces the committee amendment and changes the title. The
32 amendment directs the Maine Public Employees Retirement System to study existing and
33 potential further cooperation with other statewide retirement systems affected by the
34 windfall elimination provision and the government pension offset instead of an interstate
35 compact. The amendment requires the Maine Public Employees Retirement System to
