partnership under section 1, regarding the review conducted pursuant to this resolve and making recommendations, including recommendations for changes to policy and relating to the award of block grant funds, recommendations for specific measures or reserving of block grant funds for certain populations and recommendations for the establishment of a permanent partnership to review federal block grants received by the Department of Health and Human Services and including suggested legislation, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters. The joint standing committee may report out legislation on the subject matter of the report to the 131st Legislature in 2023.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

#### **SUMMARY**

13 This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve. It directs the Commissioner of Health and Human Services to establish a process to review Department of Health and Human 14 15 Services spending of funds received pursuant to the federal Maternal and Child Health 16 Block Grant. The commissioner is required to establish a partnership to conduct this 17 review. The partnership is between representatives of tribal public health districts, the 18 Permanent Commission on the Status of Racial, Indigenous and Tribal Populations and the 19 department. The partnership is required to review the process of awarding block grant funds 20 and the outcomes in populations served by grant funds, with a focus on identifying 21 vulnerable populations and determining if these populations are appropriately served by 22 grant funds. The commissioner is required to submit a report, drafted by the partnership, 23 with recommendations, including recommendations for the establishment of a permanent 24 partnership to review federal block grants received by the department, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters. 25 26 The joint standing committee may report out legislation on the subject matter of the report 27 to the 131st Legislature in 2023.
