Amend the resolution in that part designated "Constitution, Art. I, §25" (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "§25" and inserting the following: '§26'

Amend the resolution in that part designated "**Constitution, Art. I, §25**" in the first line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>Section 25</u>" and inserting the following: '<u>Section 26</u>'

Amend the resolution by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
