SUMMARY 23 24 This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, directs the Department of Education, no later than January 15, 2022, to submit a report to the Joint Standing 25 Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs on strategies to use alternative databases and 26 income measures to determine eligibility for public school nutrition programs. The Joint 27 Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs may submit legislation related to 28 the report to the Second Regular Session of the 130th Legislature. 29
